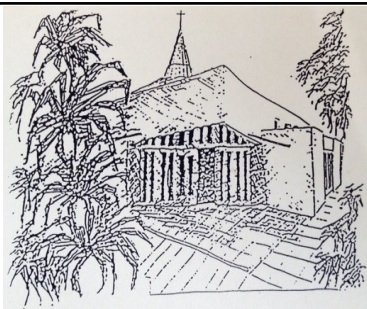

New Guidelines for Covid Step 4

Social Distancing.

From 19th July, there will be no legislation on social distancing in England. Churches may increase their capacity.

A designated seating area in the church will be kept for those who wish to continue social distancing.

Congregational singing—Indoor Congregational singing is permitted from 19th July. The use of cantor group and choirs is now permitted. **Recommended face covering while singing.**

Act of Worship—QR codes are recommended to be kept along with tract and trace signing in. Stewards will no longer be needed and the one way systems are not necessary. Acts of anointing in Baptism and for the sick can be resumed.

Celebration of the Mass—Holy water stoups are still to remain empty but bottles with Holy Water can be used. Offertory collections are resumed as normal and Holy Communion will be continued under one kind. Ministers are asked to continue to sanitise hands before distribution and wear face coverings for the present. The sign of peace is still omitted. Readers are to continue as normal without the sanitation.

Baptisms, Confirmations, Anointing of the sick, Marriages and funerals: - No Restrictions

Confessions: A Perspex barrier or curtain is needed in the confessional.

Home Visits - To be allowed **Social Activities in church** -To be allowed. **Catechical groups/Prayer groups** -To be allowed.
