### **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

We are being asked today to decide whom we will serve. For four weeks we have been presented in the liturgy with the mystery of the Eucharist. God has promised us a new homeland, eternal life, and offered us bread from heaven to strengthen us on our journey. He has given us the words of eternal life.
