The Siege and Destruction of Jerusalem (1848/1850)

David Roberts (1796-1864)

"While the Sanctuary was burning, looting went on right and left and all who were caught were put to the sword. There was no pity for age, no regard for rank; little children and old men, laymen and priests alike were butchered; every class was held in the iron embrace of war, whether they defended themselves or cried for mercy. Through the roar of the flames as they swept relentlessly on could be heard the groans of the falling: such were the height of the hill and the vastness of the blazing edifice that the entire city seemed to be on fire..." Josephus (c.37AD-c.100AD), The Jewish War (c75AD), XXI: 9

David Roberts' painting depicts the destruction of Jerusalem by the Roman general, later emperor, Titus in 70AD. Jerusalem's destruction would have reminded the early Christians of our Lord's words, "In those days, after the time of distress, the sun will be darkened, the moon will lose its brightness, the stars will come falling from heaven and the powers in the heavens will be shaken." (Mark 13: 24-27) It was a terrible, terrifying event for Jews and for Christians, yet it was not the end of the world. We really do not know when the world is going to end, or in what way. Let us learn to heed the words of our Lord, "But as for that day or hour nobody knows it, neither the angels of heaven, nor the Son; no one but the Father." (Mark 13: 32) Do not speculate about the end of the world; rather let us try to live each day as disciples of Jesus Christ.
