Jesus and the Pharisees (1886-1894)

The humour in today's Gospel is wonderful. The scribe says to Jesus, "Well spoken, Master, what you have said is true: that he is one and there is no other...." The scribe, unbeknown to him, tells the incarnate Son of God that he is speaking the truth. It was God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, who first gave to the people of Israel the Shema Yisrael which we hear in today's reading from Deuteronomy (6: 4): "Listen [or, more accurately, "Hear", which, fortunately, is the translation in the new Lectionary ] Israel: The Lord our God is the one Lord." The Shema is a declaration of faith in one God. It is incorporated in the Catholic Liturgy, read during Compline (Night Prayer) every Saturday night, thereby drawing to a conclusion the day's prayers. As disciples of the Risen Lord we should "Let these words I urge on you today be written on your heart", following God alone rather than the many false gods proffered to us by the world.
