BAPTISM OF THE LORD (C)



The Baptism of Jesus (1470-1475)

Andrea del Verrocchio (1436-1488) and Leonardo da Vinci (1452-1519)

This painting captures the wonder, the beauty, the glory and yet the tender fragility of the human body: “And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth” (John 1: 14). Above Jesus hovers the dove of the Holy Spirit, the power and glory of God: “And when he came up out of the water, immediately he saw the heavens being torn open and the Spirit descending on him like a dove. And a voice came from heaven, ‘You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased.’” (Mark 1: 10-11). Through the Incarnation of Christ our Lord our weak, frail human flesh has been raised to the glory of God’s divinity: all of us, by virtue of our baptism, share in the death of Christ, living in the hope we will share in his resurrection.

“Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death , in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life.” (Romans 6: 3-4)
