The Marriage at Cana (c.1495-1497) Master of the Catholic Kings (active c.1485-1500)

The Master of the Catholic Kings is the name given to an artist thought to have been responsible for eight paintings

In the Christmas season attention was focussed upon the Prologue to the Holy Gospel according to John: “...the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory...” (John 1: 14) In the very homely context of a village wedding where the wine runs out, today’s Gospel underlines the reality that in Jesus Christ God became man and his glory was revealed. The abundant wine is the gift of the Word who “was with God and the Word was God.” (John 1: 1)

The wine that our Lord provides is indeed the best wine saved for this moment. (John 2: 10) It is best because, while the law (and its associated rites of purification) was given through Moses, the fullness of God’s grace and truth have come into the world through Jesus Christ. The water “meant for the ablutions that are customary among the Jews” (John 2: 6) is replaced by the wine of the Kingdom of God. Those of us here at today’s Eucharist have become the guests of the divine Bridegroom of Israel at the wedding feast of Cana (cf. Hosea 2: 14-18, 21-25; Isaiah 54: 4-10; 62: 4-5).

There will be tea and coffee in the hall after the 10am Mass on Sunday

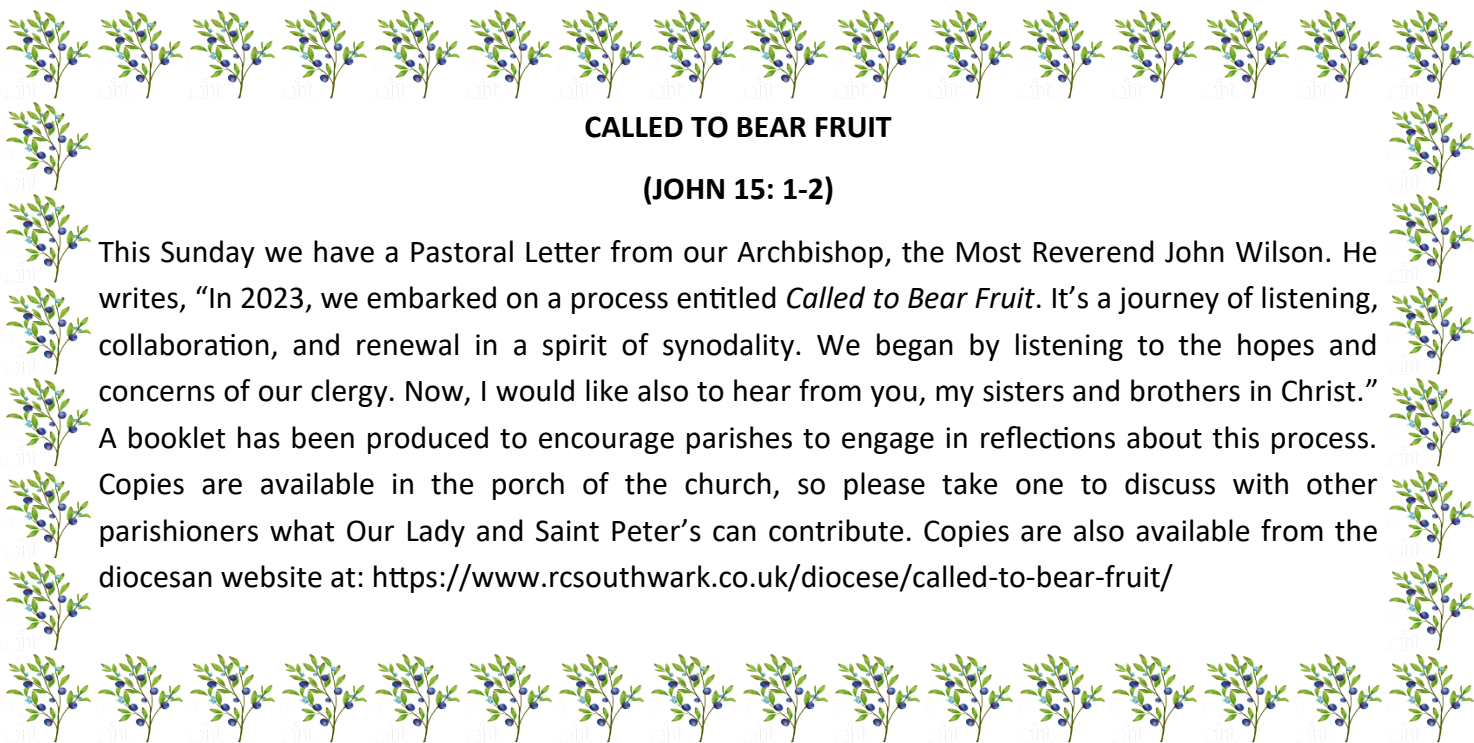
