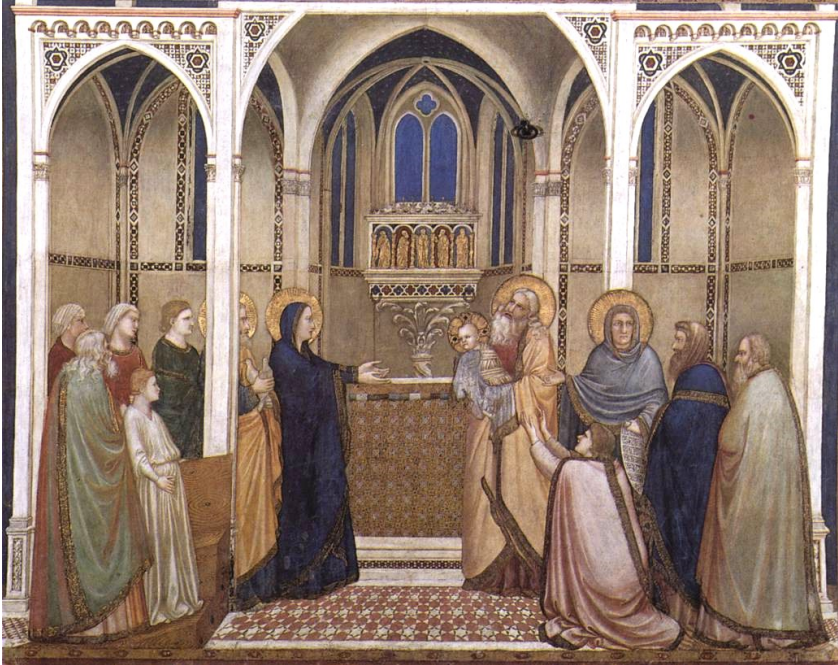

PRESENTATION OF THE LORD (C)



Presentation of Christ in the Temple (1310s)

Giotto di Bondone (1266-1337)

Today we celebrate the Presentation of the Lord when, observing what “(is written in the Law of the Lord, ‘Every male who first opens the womb shall be called holy to the Lord’) and to offer a sacrifice according to what is said in the Law of the Lord, ‘a pair of turtle-doves, or two young pigeons.’” (Luke 2: 23-24) Jesus, through his mother Mary and step-father Joseph, observed all the demands of the Law of Moses. They were a totally, wonderfully Jewish family: this is why anti-Semitism can have no place in our lives as Christians. As it says in the First Eucharistic Prayer: “Be pleased to look upon these offerings...as once you were pleased to accept the gifts of your servant Abel the just, the sacrifice of Abraham, our father in faith...” These are indeed our forefathers in faith: at a time of heightened world tension we must never, ever forget this.
