5TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (C)



Sunrise over the Sea of Galilee (Lake of Gennesaret)

This freshwater ‘sea’ is 21km long and 13km across at its widest point. Its names include the Sea of Tiberias, the Lake of Gennesaret and (in Hebrew) Lake Chinnereth or Kinneret.

“...when Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus’ knees, saying, ‘Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord.’” (Luke 5: 8) Yet, however reluctantly, Peter follows our Lord. The Gospels can be seen as the story of Jesus’ friendship with his disciples: one party is always faithful, the other parties not so. Peter continues to sin in the years to follow. Nonetheless, Jesus continually invites him to conversion. Jesus knows Peter’s weaknesses yet still calls him. Jesus calls us also, despite our weaknesses. In fact, Jesus ultimately may have called Peter to lead the church because Peter was painfully conscious of his own failings. He would never forget how far he fell, how much he failed, so remembering to rely on God’s strength, not his own. All of us need to learn, sometimes many times, to acknowledge our faults and to trust in God. As Jesus stood on Lake Gennesaret, he saw that Peter was not only bold, persistent, and courageous; he was also weak enough to be a good leader.

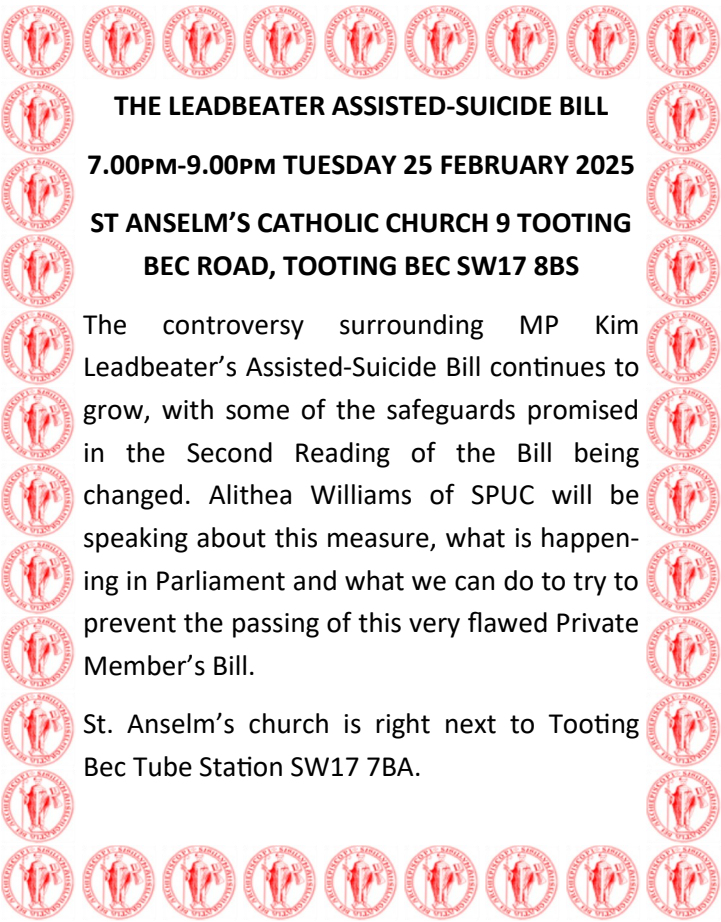
