Jesus Teaches the People by the Sea (1886-1896)

James Tissot (1836-1902)

In contrast to Matthew’s nine Beatitudes (Matthew 5: 3-11), Luke has four, followed by four corresponding Woes. The Beatitudes and the Woes make sense in the light of the coming reversal of fortune so prominent in Luke’s view of salvation. Mary proclaimed this in her Magnificat (1: 51-53); it is also the “good news to the poor” (4: 18) announced by Jesus at Nazareth. Our Lord is not endorsing poverty or hunger: he is insisting that what most people reckon to be advantages or disadvantages are reversed in the light of the coming Kingdom of God. In Luke’s Gospel the Beatitudes depict a situation of extreme vulnerability. According to what the world values—the situations addressed by the Woes—it make no sense to adopt this vulnerability. Yet in the light of the coming of God’s Kingdom, it makes very good sense indeed. Being vulnerable gives scope to God’s power.
