The Saviour’s Transfiguration (Icon c. 1403)

Jesus is indeed the longed-for Messiah of the people of Israel. But Peter, James and John, the disciples who witnessed our Lord’s Transfiguration, have to hold two truths about Jesus in a mysterious tension. On the one hand, as God’s Son and Chosen One, he has a status which is totally superior to the conventional expectations of the Messiah, which was that of a King David figure who would lead the Jewish people to warlike victory over their oppressors. On the other hand, simply because he is God’s obedient Son, his mission as the Messiah will be that of bringing freedom (‘exodus’) to Israel and, ultimately, the world through a costly entry into its pain and suffering. The glory of which the disciples have caught a glimpse will come only after the horrors of the arrest in Gethsemane, his trial before Pilate, the carrying of the Cross, and his death on Calvary. These come first; only then is the glory of the Resurrection allowed to happen, an event which takes place in the hidden silence of the garden.
