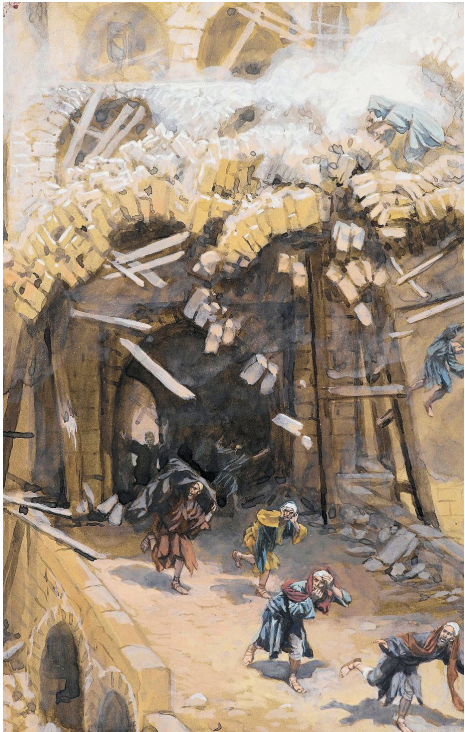

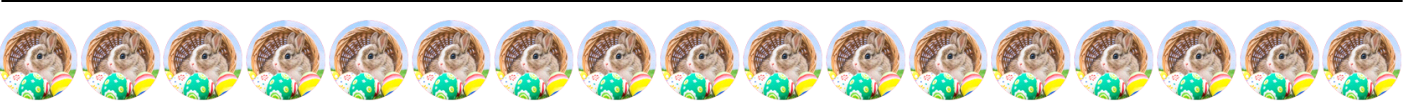
3RD SUNDAY IN LENT (C)

James Tissot (1836-1902)

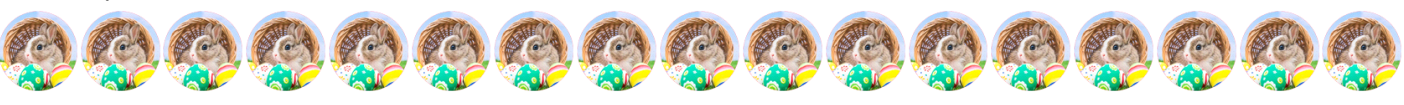
Mention of the two disasters, one caused directly by the actions of another human being (Pilate’s massacre of Galileans sacrificing in the Temple in Jerusalem), and the other completely accidental (the collapse of the tower at Siloam with a large loss of life), carry the warning to repent. Jesus firmly rejects any suggestion that the victims were being punished for a sinfulness from which others were exempt. To interpret such disasters in this selective way is totally wrong, though unfortunately the religious instinct can be prone to do so. Rather than judging the sinfulness of others, people should see such events as a warning to examine their own lives and to repent of their own sins. The parable of the fig tree is a reminder of God’s infinite patience: “The Lord is not slow to fulfil his promise as some count slowness, but is patient towards you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance.” (II Peter 3: 9) The fig tree is given one more year to bear fruit. We who hear the parable of the fig tree should remember that there will be a day of judgement. How will we use God’s patience with us to bear fruit?
