FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

In his Letter to the Galatians, St. Paul writes that the only thing he can boast about is the cross of Jesus Christ, by which he is saved. “Far be it from me to boast except on the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.” (Galatians 6: 14) Through the cross, men and women can become new creatures sharing in an intimate relationship with God, who is Father, Son and Holy Spirit. This intimacy is the result of what God has done for us, not what we have done for God. In today’s Gospel the seventy-two sent out to proclaim the Good News return to our Lord rejoicing at all they have done. Jesus acknowledges their success: “I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven” (Luke 10: 18). But he points to a greater reason for joy: “rejoice that your names are written in heaven” (Luke 10: 20). Christian joy does not rest upon achievement: it rests upon a deep sense of relationship with God and a knowledge of the destiny to which that relationship leads. “Beloved, we are God’s children now, and what we will be has not yet appeared; but we know that when he appears we shall be like him, because WE shall see him as he is.” (1 John 3: 2)
