The Good Samaritan (c.1616)

Jacques (Jacob) Jordaens (1593 –1678)

We cannot come to the true meaning of today’s parable unless we realise the hatred and distrust existing between Jews and Samaritans at the time of Jesus: “‘How is it that you, a Jew, ask for a drink from me, a woman of Samaria.’ (For Jews have no dealings with Samaritans.)” (John 4: 9. See John 4 : 1-42 for our Lord’s encounter with the Samaritan woman at the well) The parable compels its audience to identify with the experience of the wounded traveller. What did the traveller feel when this ‘enemy’, instead of robbing him further and finishing him off, approached with rescue and succour? In the parable, Jesus has not overthrown or bypassed the Law. He has simply shown that to fulfil the Law’s true intent the notion of ‘neighbour’ has to be drastically revised. The concept of ‘neighbour’ shifts from being a label we may apply to another, to being a quality or a vocation we take upon ourselves and actively live out. This is the way to inherit eternal life. The God whom one is attempting to love with all one’s heart is the God who reaches out to the world in compassion in the same way as the good Samaritan. (cf. Matthew 5: 43-48)
