16TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (C)



The Trinity; or, The Hospitality of Abraham (1411 or 1425-1427)

Andrei Rublev (c.1360-c.1430)

Together with the image of God walking with Adam and Eve “at the time of the evening breeze” (Genesis 3: 8), today’s First Reading from the same book is for me so beautiful: it tells us that whatever we may have done, God delights in being with us. In the poetic account of the creation and God walking with Adam and Eve, we hear the heartfelt cry of God: “...the Lord God called to the man, and said to him, ‘Where are you?’” (Genesis 3: 9) In the historical account of Abraham’s encounter with God by the oaks of Mamre once more we hear this same call of God: “Where are you”. God longs to be with humanity, the summit of his creation: “what are human beings that you are mindful of them, mortals that you care for them? Yet you have made them little lower than the angels, and crowned them with glory and honour” (Psalm 8: 4-5). In Jesus Christ we see the ultimate and total encounter of God with humanity: “the Word became flesh and lived among us” (John 1: 14). Here the cry of God is answered in full: we will not come to him, so he comes to us: “the mystery hidden for ages and generations, but now revealed to his saints”. (Colossians 1: 26)
