The Way to Calvary (c.1415-1420)

Today’s Gospel is about the cost of discipleship. Jesus warns the crowd accompanying him that if they really want to be his followers they have to count the cost. Being a disciple is like the man wanting to build a tower: he has to assess what he will need, not just for the foundations but whether or not he has the resources to finish the building. So it is with being a disciple of Jesus: it is all very well starting out with good intentions, swearing to do everything the Lord asks of a person, but then turning away when difficulties arise. We are reminded of the Parable of the Sower: the seed that fell on rocky ground had no root: “this is the one who hears the word and immediately receives it with joy, yet he has no root in himself, but endures for a while, and when tribulation or persecution arises on account of the word, immediately he falls away.” (Matthew 13: 1-9, 18-23) As disciples of our Lord we are not greater than our master (John 15: 20). Jesus carried his cross through the streets of Jerusalem; to be like him, we have to take up our crosses every day. Discipleship is not easy: it is costly, hard and difficult.

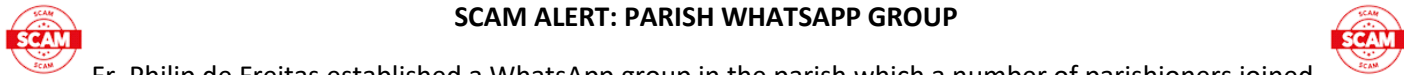

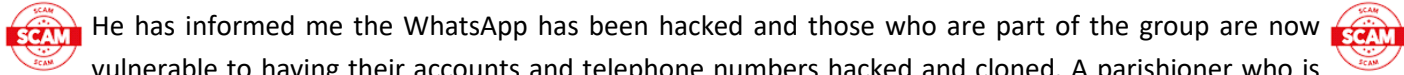

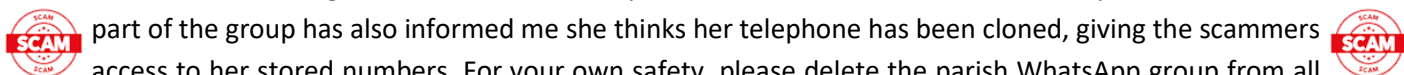
SCAM ALERT: PARISH WHATSAPP GROUP



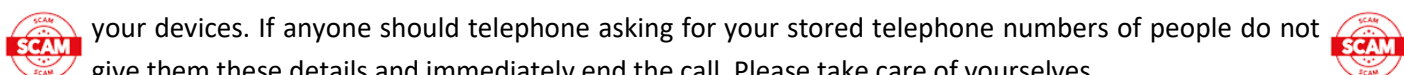
Fr. Philip de Freitas established a WhatsApp group in the parish which a number of parishioners joined.

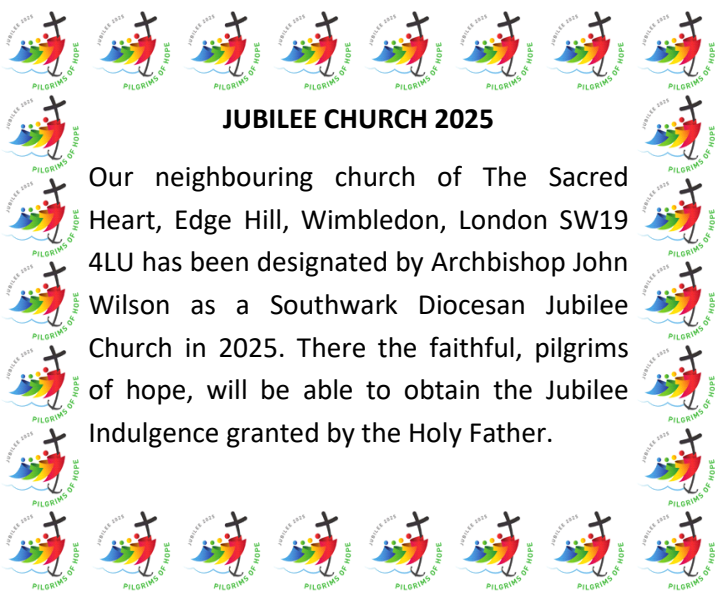
PARISH VOUCHER SYSTEM
