Mustard seeds and ground mustard powder

In the Gospel the apostles ask the Lord to increase their faith. It is as if they are thinking you can just go around and have your faith topped up so that it will grow ever larger. Well faith is not a commodity; you can’t go shopping around for it like you can goods in a super-market. “Come in, come in: top up your faith here.”

“If I just had more faith....” Many of us have thought like this at some point in our lives. If I just had more faith I wouldn’t have so many questions or doubts. If I just had more faith God would answer my prayers. If I just had more faith they wouldn’t have died, they would have recovered. If I just had more faith I would be a better person. If I just had more faith life would be different.

Jesus is very clear that faith is not about size or quantity. “If you had faith like a grain of mustard seed, you could say to this mulberry tree, ‘Be uprooted and planted in the sea’, and it would obey you.” (Luke17: 6) Faith is not a thing we have or get. Faith is a relationship of trust and love. It means opening ourselves to receive another’s life and giving our life to another. That other person is Jesus Christ our Lord. Faith is about trusting in God’s love for us and trying to respond to this love and mercy, however weak our response.
