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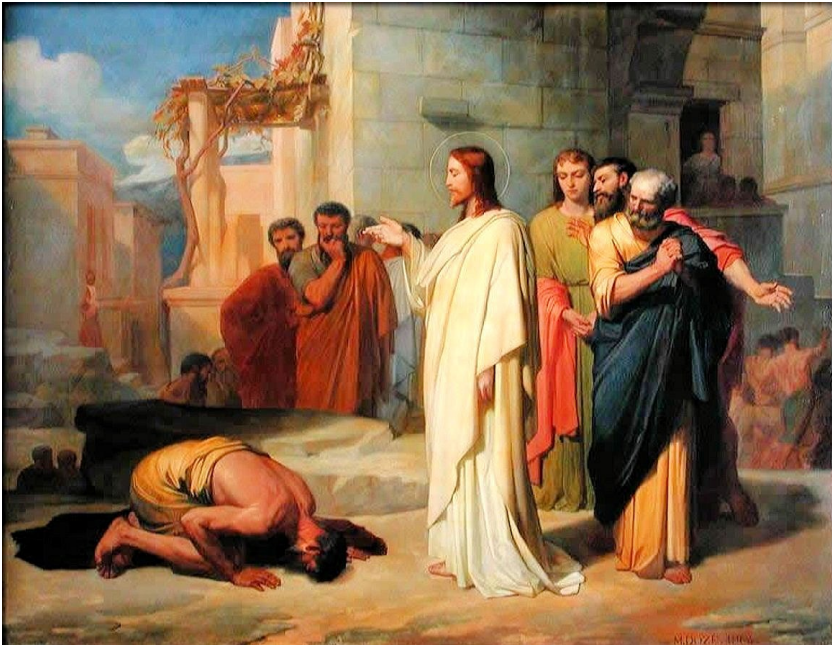

**TWENTY-EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (C)**



*Jesus Healing the Leper (1864)*  
Jean-Marie Melchior Doze (1827-1913)

As Jesus began his journey from Galilee to Jerusalem (Luke 9: 51; Year C Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time), a Samaritan village proved inhospitable. When the disciples wanted to respond violently, Jesus held them back. As the end of the journey approaches, it is a Samaritan who once again displays the appropriate response. Ten lepers cry out to Jesus for mercy. All ten are made clean when they follow Jesus’ instructions to go and show themselves to the priest (Leviticus 13:49). For nine of the lepers, that is the end of the matter. But the tenth, who is a Samaritan, returns, loudly praising God. Prostrating himself before Jesus, he receives the assurance: “Your faith has saved you” (17: 19). All ten received physical healing. But only the one on the margins (“this foreigner”, as Jesus calls him 17: 18) fully experiences salvation. Beyond physical healing, salvation means praising and thanking the God who has set us free. Which begs the question: How often do we thank God for setting us free through the birth, life, passion, death and resurrection of his Beloved Son, Jesus Christ our Lord?
