Praying Hands (c.1508)

Albrecht Dürer (1471-1528)

Albrecht Dürer’s *Praying Hands* is the most widely reproduced depiction of prayer in the Western world. So why does it seem as if God does not answer our prayers? In this matter, I cannot speak: I do not know and do not want to know your private prayers to God. They are none of my business. Yet when I look back to the prayers I said in my youth, yes, kneeling by my bed, for my knees would let me do that in the last century, I am truly glad my prayers were not answered in the way I wanted: I was unable to see things in their entirety. “When I was a child, I spoke as a child, I thought as a child, I reasoned like a child. When I became a man, I gave up childish ways. For now we see in a mirror dimly, but then face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I have been fully known.” (I Corinthians 13: 11-12) Aged 67, I have to remember I still reason as a child, and so do you; only in God’s kingdom will we fully know, realising then that we are fully known.
