FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (A)



Sermon on the Mount (Fresco 1436-1443)

Fra Angelico (1387-1455)

Most of the time the majority of us live on the surface of things: it is very easy to get caught up in appearances. The Sermon on the Mount, however, cuts very deep. It cuts away hypocrisy; it cuts away deceit and deception. The desire for revenge over intended slights is never far from the surface; jealousy is never far from the surface. In the work environment the lives of some people are made a living hell by the actions of their colleagues, who belittle them, refuse to praise them, get jealous when they are promoted or given a pay rise. “...whoever insults his brother will be liable to the council; and whoever says, ‘You fool’ will be liable to the hell of fire.” (Matthew 5: 22) In today’s Gospel Jesus goes to the heart of what it is to be a human being. At work tomorrow there will be many people called fool behind their backs: this part of the Sermon on the Mount is not just ancient sayings: it is us today, the men and the women of the twenty-first century. Jesus insists that the Christian life means a great deal more than external approval and respectability. What Jesus presents to us is a way of life that affects us to the very depths of our being. This is a hard love, a demanding love, for it is the way of humility, it is the way of truth: truth about ourselves before God; truth about ourselves before ourselves. This is why mercy and forgiveness must be at the heart of our lives as disciples.
