**ELEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (A)**



*Christ on the Cross* (1627)  
Francisco de Zurbarán (1598-1664)

In today’s first reading from the book of Exodus we hear how God calls the people of Israel to “be to me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.” (Exodus 19: 6a) Through the sacrificial death of our Lord on the cross, this dignity is extended to all the baptised, of every nation and peoples: “...you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God’s own people, in order that you may proclaim the mighty acts of him who called you out of darkness into his marvellous light.” (I Peter 2: 9) When we were baptised we were anointed with the chrism of salvation “so that, united with his people, you may remain for ever a member of Christ, who is Priest, Prophet and King.” “While the common priesthood of the faithful is exercised by the unfolding of baptismal grace—a life of faith, hope and charity, a life according to the Spirit. The ministerial priesthood [of bishops and of priests] is at the service of the common priesthood.” (*Catechism of the Catholic Church* 1547) All of this flows from the love God has for humanity: “...God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.” (Romans 5: 8)

“Know that he, the LORD, is God  
He made us; we belong to him.  
We are his people, the sheep of his flock.” (Psalm 100: 3)

Whatever may happen to us during the course of our lives, let us never forget we belong to God.
