Patience, they tell us, is a great virtue. Try telling that to your parish priest when working on his PC, waiting what seems to be an eternity for the circling blue symbol to stop and the required page to appear!! If you haven’t realised it yet, God has a wonderful sense of humour.

Thanks be to him; God has perfect patience. A perfect patience for the universe he has created, as well as for each and every single one of us. Today’s parable about the good seed and the darnel should be read as a parable of hope. We all of us do things we shouldn’t; we are all guilty of habitual sins, the sins we commit over and over again no matter how much we pray not to commit them, no matter how much we are ashamed of them. And we should be ashamed of them; we must pray not to sin again and to do all in our power not to sin. But when we fail, well, that can be the moment when we realise how much we stand in need of God’s mercy and grace. That is when we can be like the tax-collector in our Lord’s parable of the Pharisee and the Tax-Collector: “the tax-collector, standing far off, would not even look up to heaven, but was beating his breast and saying, ‘God, be merciful to me, a sinner.’” (Luke 18: 13) The darnel in the field of our lives can be the occasion of God’s grace at work in us. And in God’s time and in God’s way, one day that darnel will be rooted out so that we can be part of the rich harvest of the kingdom of God.
